A motion was made to approve the April 2023 financial statement by Magistrate Preston and seconded by Magistrate Day. All in favor.

**IN RE: GREENHOUSE 17**

Darlene Thomas, Executive Director, was in attendance. Greenhouse 17 is a domestic violence program that serves Garrard, Lincoln, Boyle and Mercer Counties. They oversee a Children’s Safe Exchange and Visitation Program in Danville, KY. Their services include emergency shelters, legal advocacy, case management, counseling, support for both adults and children who have been impacted by intimate partner violence, and supervised visitations. They are requesting support in the amount of \$14,350.00 from Garrard County for their FY 23-24 Budget. These funds will help to obtain specially trained contractors who will monitor visitations and an off-duty police officer to guard their facility during service delivery. Judge/Exec Elleman said he will follow up with Mayor Gaffney to see if the City of Lancaster is interested in contributing to this program to help share the expense.

**IN RE: GARRARD COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT BUDGET**

A motion was made to show receipt of the budget by Magistrate Day and seconded by Magistrate Preston. All in favor.

**IN RE: DESIGNATION OF APPLICANT’S AGENT RESOLUTION**

Wanda Shelton was in attendance. An agent is needed to be the first person contacted in the event of a FEMA Disaster. They will keep up with overtime, equipment, in-kind expenses, fuel, etc, associated with a disaster. A motion was made by Magistrate Davis to approve Todd Montgomery as Designee of Applicant’s Agent and seconded by Magistrate Barker. All in favor.

**IN RE: GC HOMELESS COALITION**

Lynn Gibson was in attendance. At the April 24, 2023, meeting, the Homeless Coalition offered the Fiscal Court the ability to appoint a person to their Board of Directors. Magistrate Barker thought it

would be difficult for a Magistrate to fill that position as they are still in the learning process of their new offices. Judge/Executive Elleman also thought there may be a conflict of interest when it comes to voting. He is planning a meeting with Mayor Gaffney to see if the City of Lancaster has any recommendations. Mr. Gibson said the appointee would not have to be an employee of the County and that it could be a trusted Pastor or another member of the community.

**IN RE: RUMPKE VOUCHER SYSTEM**

Judge/Executive Elleman has been in contact with Rumpke regarding usage of the dump. An established voucher system would do away with a limited two-day spring and two-day fall "Free Dump Days". This would allow community members to go on the Garrard County website and print off 4 vouchers to be used at any point during the year. The hope is that this will alleviate a lot of the trash in the county piling up waiting for the semi-annual dump days. It would also help with traffic being backed up on Hwy 52 when being limited to two weekends per year. The voucher system is implemented by Bluegrass ADD and all monitoring is done by them. The initial setup fee is estimated to be \$5,000.00 with a \$600.00 annual maintenance fee. The Magistrates would like to contact Maxine Rudder with Bluegrass Greensource to see if the cost could be covered by a Solid Waste grant. More follow-up on the matter will need to be done.
